Saturday: Various Seminars (skinning and using the whole animal, backcountry bowhunting, and more!), optional spaghetti dinner, and bowhunting campfire chat

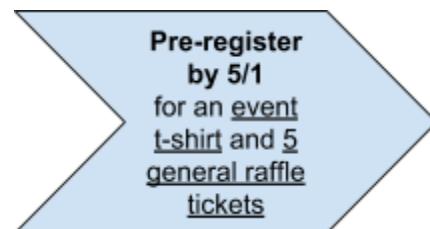
Sunday: Broadhead Shoot, BBQ, and RAFFLE

Last Chance Broadhead Shoot Rules and Regulations

1. This tournament is designed to appeal to the bowhunter as opposed to the tournament archer. It is designed to offer the hunter some benefits without his/her becoming entangled in the aspects of a Field Tournament. NFAA rules do not apply to this event.
2. Sonoma County Bowmen's President and Vice President of Hunting shall govern this tournament.
3. The ranges for this event shall be laid out in such a manner as to simulate hunting conditions when possible.
4. Archers shall use hunting tackle for this event, which is keeping with California State Fish and Wildlife laws on Big Game Hunting.
5. Scoring:
 - a.) Vital- 10 Kill- 8 Wound- 5
 - b.) An arrow must be in the target to score, except a "pass-through", which must be witnessed and scored as witnessed by other shooters in the group.
 - c.) "Bounce-ins" and "glance-offs" shall not score. d.) "Antlers" do not score.
 - e.) Shaft of arrow must touch the line for higher score. f.) Double-scoring is required.
 - g.) This is a one-arrow tournament at unmarked yardage.
6. Divisions and Shooting Styles:

Male (M)	Compound (C)
Female (F)	Longbow (LB)

7. Awards:

Awards will be given to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place male and female for each shooting style.
8. Tackle:
 - a.) A front stabilizer, not over 12 inches, shall be allowed in each shooting style (no length limit to back bars).
 - b.) Bow quivers allowed in each shooting style (Quivalizers are allowed).
 - c.) RANGEFINDERS and BINOCULARS are allowed on the range.
 - d.) Broadheads or practice blades are allowed if they meet the California Department of Fish and Wildlife Big Game Hunting regulations (7/8" diameter)

Directions to shoot 291 Seavey Road in Petaluma:

From Hwy 101 North or South:

- Take Washington Street Exit
- Head west toward Bodega/Coast Guard Base (9 miles)
- Turn left on Spring Hill Road
- Turn right on Seavey Road (1 mile)
- Rancho Neblina is on the left side (entry gates marked)

PLEASE DRIVE SLOWLY into the Ranch (Dutra's ranch)
